ANNOUNCEMENT ON CHANGES TO CAMPUS OPERATIONS DUE TO CMCO ENFORCEMENT IN SELANGOR, KUALA LUMPUR & PUTRAJAYA

With reference to the statement issued by the National Security Council on the 12th of October 2020, the Management of the University of Cyberjaya has made the following changes to the campus operations effective 14th of October 2020 to 27th October 2020.

- i. All lecture and tutorials will be conducted online only. Students will be advised by your Faculty on the lecturer timetable and means to access our online learning tools.
- ii. All laboratory and practical sessions on campus will be rescheduled to a date after the CMCO has been lifted.
- iii. All in-person extra-curricular activities will be temporarily suspended.
- iv. All clinical placements outside of Selangor, KL and Putrajaya will proceed as scheduled while all in-state clinical placements will be suspended until further notice by your individual faculties.
- v. All examinations will either be rescheduled or implemented online. Please consult your Faculty for detailed instructions.
- vi. The University Library, Computer Labs and Cafeteria will remain operational from Mondays – Fridays, 9am to 4pm. Students will be allowed to access these facilities to aid in the online learning process.
- vii. The Campus offices will remain operation from Mondays – Fridays, 9am to 4pm.
- viii. Accommodation services will remain operational. Students are encouraged to remain in Cyberjaya or within safe traveling distance to the campus as practical sessions may resume with little notice upon approval by the Ministry. However, these students must adhere to the University SOP and the Management of UoC will monitor the students’ movement from time to time.
- ix. Students who wish to return to their hometowns will be allowed to do so but they are advised to be on stand-by to return to campus when the CMCO is lifted/relaxed.

It is reminded that every student is mandatorily required to observe and comply to the University Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) as well as all safety measures announced by the National Security Council or be liable for a police fine of RM1,000 or more. As this is a fast-developing situation, students and parents are advised to be on stand-by for any changes in instructions by the Ministry and the Government. Thank you.
