CUCMS promotes a healthy and safe university environment. This circulation as a gentle reminder to all CUCMS community especially the students about a warning about smoking ban and the banning of electronic or vapor cigarettes in CUCMS campus.

In accordance with the provisions under the Food Act 1983 and the Tobacco Revenue Control Regulations 2004 has provided that places of smokers include in any area within educational institutions or institutions of higher learning as set out in section IV, Article 11 (1) (j) of the relevant act.

Therefore, all Education Institutions or Higher Education Institutions have been gazetted as non-smoking areas.

In accordance to CUCMS Code of Conduct:

“Smoking is prohibited within the University premises as well as within its branch campus”

With this the act of smoking and any form of electronic or vape smoking is strictly prohibited within the campus area.

In the event of a breach or non-compliance with this prohibition, the CUCMS administration will take firm action on this issue which fall under the Major Misconduct which the penalty as below:

- (a) Written undertaking from the student to be of good conduct and behaviour for a period of 3 months from the date of undertaking
- (b) A First Written Warning to be given to the student and to be placed in Student’s Record
- (c) A Final Written Warning to the same effect as in (b) above. It shall state the right of appeal with a copy to be placed in Student’s record
- (d) A fine up to RM200-00
- (e) Compensation for damage or loss caused
- (f) Suspension not exceeding 3 months.
