

CONVOCATION GUIDEBOOK

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The guidebook contains the procedures and guidelines for graduands pertaining to what they should prepare or do before; on; and after the conferment day. It also presents relevant information on the 13th Convocation Ceremony of the University of Cyberjaya.

Please read this guide thoroughly.

2.0 THE CEREMONY

This ceremony will involve graduates from the Class of 2023 in the postgraduate, bachelor's, and diploma programmes. It will be held in **four (4) sessions** over two (2) separate days, on the 25th and 26th of November 2023 at Grand Hall, Level 4, UoC Campus.

Kindly refer to the following page for the details of programmes to receive the conferment according to date and session. The ceremony will commence with the conferment of honorary awards to distinguished individuals who have contributed to the expansion of knowledge, social good, development of their profession, and growth in their industry and the nation at large.

Please refer to Appendix 1 for the tentative itinerary of the ceremony.

3.0 BEFORE THE CONVOCATION CEREMONY

Here are a few things that you need to do/need to be undertaken before the convocation ceremony.

CONVOCATION PRE-REQUISITE AND CLEARANCE 3.1

1. Get notified on the 'Procedures for Graduands (Class of 2023)'

Please begin the graduation process immediately (mandatory for all graduands, whether you attend/do not attend the ceremony):

- Fill up the UoC Alumni Survey;
- ii. Obtain full clearance in Section 1: Study Completion Clearance Form:
- Clear any outstanding fees before 10 November 2023 (Friday);
- Request Completion of Study Letter (all students) & First-Class iv. Honours Verification Letter (only for CGPA 3.67 achievers for PTPTN loan exemption purposes).

2. Get an official 'Invitation to the University of Cyberjaya 13th **Convocation Ceremony**

Here are the things that you need to do:

- Check your graduation status on the UoC convocation website; https://cyberjaya.edu.my/convocation;
- ii. Clear any outstanding amount due to the University (if any);
- iii. Pay the convocation fee of **RM450** and keep a copy of the payment slip; and

- iv. Complete the Ministry of Higher Education (MoHE) Graduate Tracer
 Study online and keep a copy of the confirmation slip.
 - It is compulsory for graduand of diploma, bachelor's & postgraduate degree programmes, either attending or not attending the ceremony, to complete the MoHE Graduate Tracer Study questionnaires at https://graduan.mohe.gov.my/SKPG2023. This is an initiative of the MoHE to improve the standard of higher education in Malaysia by obtaining views and feedback from graduands.
 - The confirmation slip must be uploaded by every graduand upon submission of confirmation of attendance, which will be verified by the Global Engagement Department (GED) on the day of academic regalia collection.
 - If the collection of regalia and/or scroll and transcript is by a representative, the representative must provide a copy of the tracer study slip on behalf of graduand.
 - Each graduands must complete the survey by 10 November 2023 (Friday).
 - Should you have any issues with accessing and filling up the questionnaires, kindly email ged@cyberjaya.edu.my.

Please refer to Appendix 2 for the Payment Instructions (Convocation).

3. Confirm your attendance

You must confirm your attendance online via https://cyberjaya.edu.my/convocation by 10 November 2023 (Friday). You will be required to upload the following:

- i. Study Completion Clearance Form (partially completed in Section 1)
- ii. Payment Slips for the Convocation Fee
- iii. MoHE Graduates Tracer Study Confirmation Slip

4. Pay the convocation fee

Every graduand will be charged a convocation fee of RM450. Please make payment before you confirm your attendance for the ceremony by 10 November 2023 (Friday).

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COLLECTION OF REGALIA 3.2

For the collection of regalia, each graduand must print the 'Study Completion Clearance Form' and begin the Section 2 (Part A) clearance from counter to counter:

- **Graduand Committee** i.
- ii. Global Engagement Department
- Robe Committee

Graduands of diploma, bachelor's degree, postgraduate and programmes are encouraged to collect the Regalia themselves at the Robe Counter. Please refer to **Appendix 3** for the schedule.

If a representative (immediate family member only) is collecting the regalia on behalf of the graduand, please submit the Authorisation to Collect Regalia Form (available on the convocation website) and its required supporting documents.

Please ensure that the following items are obtained from the convocation officer at the collection counter.

- a) Mortar board / Bonnet (doctorate)
- b) Hood
- c) Robe

Graduands must wear a complete regalia on the convocation day.

3.3 REHEARSAL SESSION

All graduands who are scheduled to receive their awards in Session 1 and 2 are required to be present for the rehearsal session as below:

4.0 THE CONVOCATION CEREMONY

Since the ceremony is an official ceremony with certain protocol needs to be observed, graduands must adhere to dress code and rules stipulated herein.

^{*} Graduands scheduled for the Session 1 are to gather at R103-107, Level 1, Academic Block, for the rehearsal session at 2.45 pm.

^{**} All other graduands are to assemble at the UoC Grand Hall at 2:45 pm.

^{***} Please note that only graduands are allowed in UoC premises.

CONVOCATION CEREMONY DRESS CODE 4.1

All graduands of diploma, bachelor's degree & postgraduate programmes must observe the following dress code:

Male Graduands:

- a) Long sleeve shirt with tie and dark trousers.
- b) Hair length should not touch the collar of the shirt.

Female Graduands:

- a) National dress or formal dress.
- b) Light coloured tudung (for those who wear tudung).
- c) Light coloured attire with long sleeves.
- d) Female Indian graduates are ONLY ALLOWED to wear sari (covering the belly) as an option.
- e) Female students with long hair are recommended to tie up their hair lower down the neck to avoid difficulties in wearing the mortar board / bonnet.

Graduands are **not allowed** to wear the following on stage:

- 'Purdah'.
- b) Turbans (except for Sikhs).
- c) Skirts with slits.
- d) Skirts with hemline above the knee.
- e) Dresses made from transparent materials without lining.

Dress code for shoes is as follows:

- Graduands are advised to wear only black shoes.
- Graduands are strictly prohibited to wear:
 - a) Striking coloured shoes
 - b) High heels and slippery shoes
 - c) Sports shoes
 - d) Sandals and slippers

Please note that graduands of diploma, bachelor's degree and postgraduate programmes will be wearing the Academic Regalia, hood and mortar board / bonnet.

Tips on Wearing the Academic Regalia:

- The academic regalia must be worn smartly and in a proper manner.
- The hood must cover both shoulders.
- The mortar board must be worn in such a position with the tassel hung on the left side.
- It may be useful to bring pins to hold the hood to the robe, and hairpins/pins to the mortar board.

Reminder:

- Robes cannot be altered and are to be returned as the scheduled given in its best condition.
- Graduands who do not comply with the academic regalia requirements will not be allowed to enter the convocation hall.

4.2 **CEREMONY ETIQUETTES**

- In the ceremony hall, everybody needs to maintain proper decorum. This is a solemn event to honour graduands' accomplishments and therefore we expect all participants to conduct themselves in a manner befitting the occasion.
- Academic regalia must be worn throughout the ceremony.
- Graduands must remain in the hall throughout the ceremony.
- Graduands and guests are asked to stand during the entry and exit of the grand procession.
- Hand phones are kept in silent mode within the Grand Hall.
- Cameras and video cameras are disallowed in the Grand Hall.
- Graduands and guest are not permitted to take any photo or video during the ceremony.
- Drinking, eating and smoking are strictly prohibited in Grand Hall.
- To preserve the dignity of the ceremony and the safety of those in attendance, invited guests are not permitted to be on the stage before or during the ceremony.
- Graduands should be respectful to other members of the graduating class.

4.3 **DURING CONFERMENT OF DEGREE**

Prior to receipt of scroll, graduands are asked to line up along the right side of the wall of the Grand Hall and proceed to the stairs onto the stage when asked to do so. When graduand's name is called, cross the stage to the Chancellor

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who is seated at the center, bow at the designated point, and collect the scroll from the table/tray. After taking the scroll, walk across the stage and pose for second photoshoot, then proceed down the stairway, and get back to the allocated seat quietly. No shaking of hands allowed.

5.0 POST-CONVOCATION CEREMONY

5.1 **RETURNING OF REGALIA**

To return the regalia, each graduate must bring along the 'Study Completion Clearance Form' and begin the Section 2 (Part B) clearance.

Graduates must return to the academic regalia in good condition. A fine will be imposed on the graduands for late return, damaged or loss of regalia as stated below:

Charges will be imposed for the late return of regalia, effective 2 December 2023 (Saturday).

5.2 COLLECTION OF ACADEMIC SCROLL AND ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT

Each graduate must bring along the 'Study Completion Clearance Form' and begin the Section 3 clearance for collection of academic scroll and transcript. Graduates MUST get clearance in all sections of the form to be allowed to collect the academic transcript and scroll.

Graduates who have cleared all outstanding with UoC will be allowed to collect their academic scroll and academic transcript.

Students must make sure that they have completed all the processes outlined in the **Study Completion Clearance Form (in Sections 1 and 2)** as failing to complete any of them or clear the outstanding fees will hold the collection of academic transcript and academic scroll.

Graduands who wish to send representatives (immediate family members only) to collect the scroll on their behalf are required to fill in the Authorisation to Collect Academic Scroll and Academic Transcript Form (available on the convocation website) and submit it with a copy of the identification card/passport of the representative and copy of graduand's identification card/passport as proof of authorization.

Graduates who are not able to collect the academic transcript and academic scroll within the stipulated period must submit a notification/request letter to the Examination Unit of Registrar's Office.

6.0 GUIDE FOR PARENTS AND GUESTS

6.1 ENTRANCE FOR PARENTS AND GUESTS

UoC will be inviting the graduand's parents / guardians / family members / guests to be present at the ceremony. However, it is important that you make necessary arrangement pertaining to the following:

- Graduand for each session will be given two (2) hall entrance passes. No replacement cards will be given if the card is lost on the conferment day. The Hall Pass can be collected by graduands who confirmed their attendance at https://cyberjaya.edu.my/convocation during regalia collection day or during registration on the ceremony day.
- Guests are required to bring and present the Hall Pass before entering the Grand Hall.
- Children below 12 years old are not allowed to enter the Grand Hall.
- Graduands and guests are not permitted to take photographs and video whilst in the hall.
- Graduand and guests who need wheelchairs shall notify the Graduand Committee in advance.
