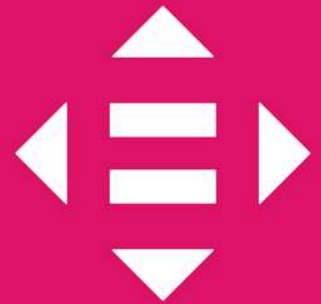

## Non-discriminatory admissions

University measures applications and admissions of underrepresented groups including **ethnic minorities, low-income students, disabled students**, and newly settled **refugee students**.

University provides **inclusive education** for disadvantaged groups and ensures no groups should be left behind. They are included in mentor-mentee and counselling services provided by the university. Subsidised **Bachelor's Degree Scholarship Programme** provided by government programme, **MITRA** specifically for Malaysian Indian students.

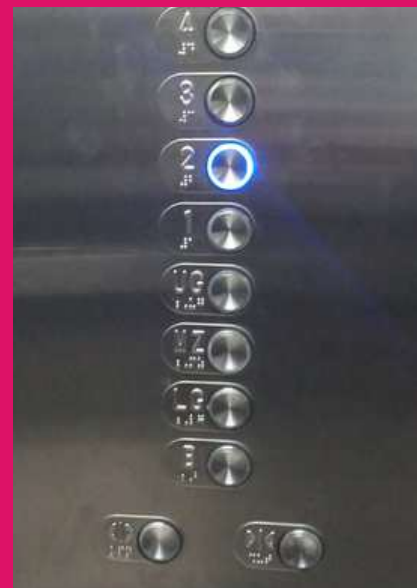
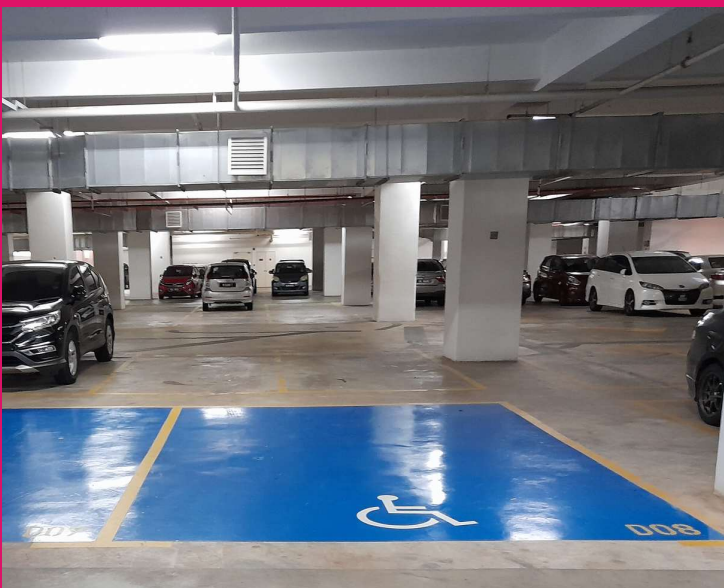
