


The Centre for Foundation, Language, and General Studies hosted Eid Celebration attended by staff and students from various ethnic background and nationality.

University provides accommodation at Edusphere Suites which is **270m distance** and **4 minutes walk** from University's campus. This encourages students to walk reducing the carbon foootprint.

Cycling

The university supports cycling by providing space for **shared biking service station** by **Tryke**, Malaysia's first shared **e-scooter** and **parking space** for bicycles. Cyberjaya city has cycling lanes to encourage cycling.



Sustainable Commuting

Free bus shuttle

Free bus shuttle services are provided daily from varsity lodge (hostel) to campus. This encourages bus pool and reduces carbon footprint.

Sustainable Commuting

Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) Cyberjaya Usage Survey

Facilities department conducted a survey MRT usage among staff and students to improve free bus shuttle services which can encourage pooling and reduce carbon footprint.

76% of respondents from the survey uses MRT as main mode of transportation.

108 respondents take **MRT feeder bus** to commute between MRT station and university campus.
