#### Turtle Invasion Awareness Campaign

**Students** from the **Environmental** Volunteerism conducted course **'Turtle** Invasion Awareness Campaign' to create awareness to the general public about the value of turtle conservation, steps to help ensure their protection and encouraging responsible behavior such as reducing plastic waste, avoiding products made from turtles, supporting regional conservation efforts and disclosing any illegal activities to turtles.

Students gave a **talk** to Cyberjaya Lake Garden park visitors about turtle invasion awareness and conducted a **clean up** of the area around the lake and disposed the collected trash appropriately.

#### **Overfishing**

movie screening featuring documentary 'Seaspiracy' was conducted during SDG Week in collaboration with Malaysian Vegetarian Society and The Green Spoon to raise awareness about illegal, overfishing. unreported. unregulated fishing, destructive fishing practices, promote conservation and sustainable utilisation of the oceans and marine resources.



The interactive Q&A session was led by Faisal Mansor repesenting Malaysian Vegetarian Society, ProVeg Malaysia, the green spoon malaysia and Diyana Rahim from Youths United For Earth (YUFE) and Animal Alliance Asia. It sparked meaningful discussions aimed at nurturing curiosity and inspiring change. Attendees were treated to plant-based finger foods.



#### **Beach Clean-up**
