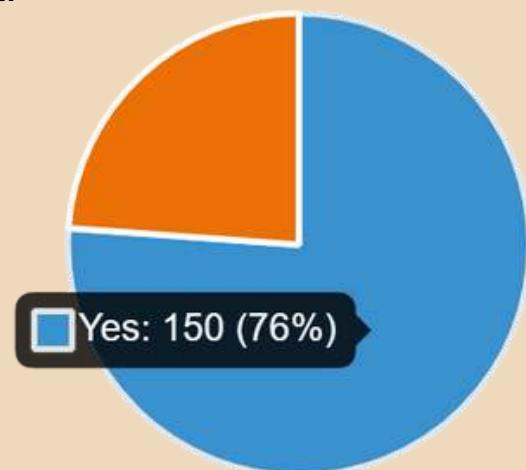

Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) Cyberjaya Usage Survey



Facilities department conducted a survey **MRT usage** among staff and students to improve free bus shuttle services which can encourage pooling and reduce carbon footprint.

76% of respondents from the survey uses MRT as main mode of transportation.



108 respondents take **MRT feeder bus** to commute between MRT station and university campus.
